

**Confirm printed paper size:**

**Pay attention and read the instructions carefully in order to measure accurately!**

1. Before printing, set page scaling to "NONE" on the print dialog box.
2. Once printed, measure the bar below to ensure it is exactly 5 inches long.
3. If measurement wasn't accurate, please check that you are printing at FULL SIZE and reprint before continuing.



**Method A – Measure finger with cutout paper sizer:**

1. Carefully cut with scissors along the outline of the finger sizer. Make a small slit where it says "Cut Here".
2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the printed numbers facing out.
3. Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit you made.
4. Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger (this could be the knuckle).
5. Pull the Sizer tightly around your finger until it is snug.
6. The number that is aligned with the slit represents the ring size for that finger.



**Method B - Measure Current Ring:**

1. Select a properly sized ring for the intended finger (The "ring finger" is located between the small finger and the middle finger, worn on the left hand in the U.S).
2. Place the ring over the circles below and match the **inside edge** of the ring to the circle closest in size. The numbers below refer to the diameter of the ring.
3. Order the larger size, if the ring falls between two sizes.
